Aboriginal Student Learning and Support Officer (ASLSO)

School Context:

South Grafton High School is a rural, comprehensive, co—educational high school with an enrolment of 740 students. A significant number of our students are from a low SES background and 27% identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander. We aim to foster successful learners who are confident, creative individuals and active, informed citizens. This is achieved through sustained, continuous improvement and development of leadership potential, whilst embedding our core Positive Behaviour for Learning (PB4L) values. Our school provides learning environments that cater for individual student learning needs, as well as opportunities that allow all students to develop to their full potential. This includes an integrated model that supports four MC classes, an ED class, and a Tutorial class.

Position Information:

Expression of interest for a Temporary ASLSO position at South Grafton High School commencing the second half of Term 1 2022, until the end of 2022, with the possibility of the contract extending.

The position requires:

- Meet DoE conditions of employment
- Current WWCC and Department of Education mandatory training
- Confirmation of Aboriginality
- The ability to support students In-class across a range of subjects and to deliver small group literacy and numeracy programs.

Selection criteria:

- Ability to work with students with emotional, physical, or intellectual disabilities
- Demonstrated ability to work as part of a team
- Ability to support the organisation and advocacy of Aboriginal students
- Ability to work professionally as part of the school staff
- Ability to work sensitively with Aboriginal girls to development programs
